- Q. 5 Make miniature library and write some lines on chart about it. (Roll No. 25 to 30)

- Q. 3 Prepare model of various means/ways through which water can be conserved. (Roll No. 1 to 10)
- Q. 4 Prepare model of means of communication. (Roll No. 11 to 20)
- Q. 5 Prepare chart on Mahatma Gandhi. (Charkha, Three monkeys, Dandi March etc.) (Roll No. 21 to 30)

CONVERSING IN SIMPLE ENGLISH

- Encourage your child to talk in English at home, using simple sentences. We teachers are trying to teach them simple sentences like :
 - ☛ May I come in Ma'am?
 - ☛ May I drink water Ma'am?
 - ☛ May I go to the washroom Ma'am?
 - ☛ Ma'am please give me pencil / eraser / sharpener.
 - ☛ Ma'am I have completed my work.
 - ☛ Excuse me Ma'am. (If they want ask some thing)
- Children can be encouraged to use simple words and sentences at home also :
 - ☛ Please give me something to eat.
 - ☛ Can I have a glass of water please.
 - ☛ May I watch T.V.?
 - ☛ Can I please go to play outside?
 - ☛ Please give me a toy.
 - ☛ Please open the door.

We teachers and parents together can make a sincere effort to help our children learn to understand and speak English well.

IMBIBE FOLLOWING SOCIAL SKILLS IN YOUR CHILD.

- Greeting with a smile when someone comes to the house.
- Conversing freely with visitors, relatives coming over to the house
- Answering the phone calls with a polite “Hello!”, also asking “May I know who is calling?”.
- Sitting at the dining table with the family to eat the meals.
- Speaking politely to the peer group.
- Sharing with the peers.

- Giving respect to her/his elders and loving her/his younger ones.
- Wishing and welcoming guests.
- Spending the time with grand parents.
- Taking care of pets. (incase, you have any).

- Do not throw litter here and there. Use dustbin all the time.
