- Phases of the Moon: Draw a black background with 8 moons, showing how to changes from a thin crescent to a full moon. (R. No. 1-10)
- Q. 2 Magnetic Crane: Build a small Crane using cardboard and a string. Attach a strong magnet to the end of the string to show how it can pick up "Waste from a pile of magnetic scrap".
- Temperature Scale: Draw two long thermometers side – by – side to show how 0°C Equals 32°F (Freezing point and 100°C equals 212°F boiling point). (R. No. 11-20)
- Q. 3 Properties of materials: Floating and sinking – Create a display tank labelled different objects (wood, iron, nail, plastic, stone) and place them in water to show which materials are dense and which are less dense.
- Plants vs Animals Cells – Draw two large cells label the cell wall and chloroplasts only in the plant cell to show the main differences. (R. No. 21-30)
- Q. 4 Electricity circuit board – Use a small battery, A LED bulb and some copper wire on a wooden board or thermocol board.
- Using a safety pin to show how a complete circuit works to light up a bulb.
- Water cycle – Illustrate a landscape showing.
