Subject : English

Q. 1 Topic: Vowel – flowers (Roll No. 1 to 7)

Cut 5 paper flowers. Write a, e, is, o, u in the center. On the petals, write 3 words for each vowel.

Example: for 'a' – cat, bat, paste them on chart.

Q. 2 Topic Picture Story (Roll No. 8 to 14)

Read any one short story from your textbook. Draw your favorite scene from it and write 5 lines about what is happening in your drawing.

Q. 3 Topic: Journey of a word (Roll No. 15 to 21)

Make a flow chart showing how we use words in sentences.

- Q. 4 "The Grammar house" (Roll No. 22 to 28)
Build a 3D house using cardboard or thermocol.
Roof: Label it - "Grammar House".
Rooms: Each room – one grammar topic from your syllabus.
- Noun Room – Paste pictures of person place, animal, thing.
 - Verb Room – Show action words with stick figures running, eating, reading.
 - Adjective Room – Display things + describing words.
 - Tense Room – Make 3 small clocks showing past, present, future with 1 sentence each.
- Garden: Put "Punctuation flowers" – full stop, comma, question mark made from clay.

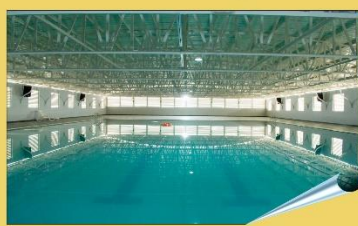
